Sub:- Steps to be taken for making Howrah (Rural) District area "Smoke-Free".

In pursuance of letter number DHFWS/HOW/127/2015 dt. 02.02.2015 of the Chief Medical Officer of Health and Secretary, DHFWS, Howrah it has been decided that Howrah will be declared as Tobacco free on 31.05.2015 (World No Tobacco Day). Before that, extensive campaign activities needs to be undertaken for the fulfillment of this goal. Hence, all Police stations is to have some specific signages in the conspicuous places and in every entrance of them. So some signages along with the requisition for challans and Receipt book and draft letters notifying all public places and educational institutions by the respective Police stations through simple letters are sent herewith for your information and taking necessary action. All Police Stations are asked to prepare schedule of weekly raids at their own level and act accordingly. Finally, proactive actions on the part of Police Stations in Tobacco Control will be the stepping stone to make Howrah a truly smoke -free District.
