Subject: Trade License for Shops Selling Tobacco Products and Compliance of Legislations

You are instructed to take appropriate actions to provide vendor license to all vendors selling tobacco products as mentioned in the Section 201 of the West Bengal Municipal Act, 1993(Sec Schedule II of Section 201) which states tobacco cannot be stored or sold without a license or written permission and prescribes to make license mandatory for vendors selling tobacco products in municipal areas of West Bengal.

However, in doing so you are also requested to ensure the followings;

- As per the Section 6(b) of Cigarette and other Tobacco products Act -2003 (COTPA-2003) it is to be ensured that tobacco products are being sold or offered within 100 yards of the outer boundary/main gate of any educational institution .Hence, no tobacco vending license is to be issued to any vendor doing business in the aforesaid area.
- 2. For compliance of the Section 5 of COTPA,2003 the following things must be ensured by the tobacco vendors;
 - a. At the point of sale a white board may be displayed to show that tobacco products are sold here. However, the size of the board used for the advertisement of cigarette and any other tobacco products for sale shall not exceed sixty centimeters by forty -five centimeters.
 - b. Each such board shall contain one of the following warnings in Bengali or in English or in Hindi or in Urdu occupying the top edge of the board in a prominent manner measuring 20 cm by 15 cm namely.
 - i. Tobacco causes cancer or
 - ii. Tobacco kills
 - c. The health warning referred to in sub-rule2 must be prominent, legible and in black colour with white background.
 - d. The display board shall contain only list of type tobacco products available and no brand pack shot, brand name of the tobacco products or other promotional message and picture. The display board shall not be backlit or illuminated in any manner.

- 3. In order to ensure the compliance of Section 6(a) of COTPA-2003 the tobacco vendors shall ensure that;
 - a. A board with a warning as specified in "Annexure-1" is displayed at the entrance of the place where cigarettes or other tobacco products are sold.
 - b. No tobacco products are sold through a vending machine.
 - c. No tobacco products are handled or sold by a person below the age eighteen years.
 - d. Tobacco products are not displayed in a manner that enables easy access of tobacco products to person below the age of eighteen years.

In this regard the tobacco vendors may be informed that the onus of proof, that the buyer of the tobacco products is not a person below the age of eighteen years lies with the seller of the tobacco products and the seller in case of doubts may request the buyer to provide appropriate evidence or age proof of having reached eighteen years of ages.

The tobacco vendors may also be informed about Section 77 of Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 which says that, Whoever gives or causes to be given to any child any intoxicating liquor or any narcotic drug or tobacco products or psychotropic substance, except on the order of a duly qualified medical practitioner shall be liable to a fine which may extend up to one lakh rupees. According to Section 2(12) of the Act "child" means a person who no completed 18 years age.

It is essential that all necessary steps are to be taken to implement Section 201 of West Bengal Municipal Act,1993 Section 5 and Section 6 of COTPA,-2003 and Section 77 of Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 in Raiganj, Dalkhola, Kaliyaganj and Islampur Municipal areas to make it compliant with legislations mentioned above.


