- 6. Regional Transport Officer, Nadia
- 7. District Inspector Secondary, Nadia
- 8. District Inspector- Primary, Nadia
- 9. District Programme Officer- Sarva Siksha Mission, Nadia

The terms of reference of the enforcement squad are the following:

- i. Fortnightly Raid- Schedule to be prepared in consultation with all concerned.
- ii. Place of Start- it might be Police station or any other pre-decided place.
- iii. Vehicle to be provided by the Health Department.
- iv. A minimum of 3 members are to be present.
- v. Representatives of the members of the Enforcement Squad can be there.
- vi. From Police-Not below the rank of Sub-inspector is a must.
- vii. Reporting of Raids in the prescribed format to be made every month to District Nodal Officer, NTCP and Dy. CMOH-II, Nadia.

It was decided in the same meeting that the enforcement squads would enforce the provision of COTPA 2003 and its subsequent rules by undertaking periodic visits to different public places and Educational Institutions and impose Penalties on violations.
